

DUNBLANE HOLIDAY (Reel 1x88)

Square set

This dance was written as a result of the very enjoyable holiday a group of us spent dancing at The Dunblane Hydro, courtesy of Furlong's Travel.

1-8 Four couples circle round and back

9-10 Ladies dance right hand across one quarter of the way round the set.

11-12 Ladies turn the man they meet all the way round with the left hand. (First lady turns second man, second lady turns third man, third lady turns fourth man, fourth lady turns first man).

13-14 Ladies dance right hand across one quarter of the way round the set.

15-16 Ladies turn the man they meet with the left hand, and finish alongside him. (First lady turns third man, second lady turns fourth man, third lady turns first man, fourth lady turns second man).

17-18 First lady joins nearer hands with third man, third lady joins nearer hand with first man, they dance into the centre and turn away from each other to face their corners. (First man faces fourth lady, first lady faces second man, third man faces second lady, third lady faces fourth man).

19-20 All set

21-28 All dance reel of four across the dance, giving right shoulders to begin.

29-32 First couple dance between second man and fourth lady to position as at the end of bar sixteen. Third couple dance similarly between fourth man and second lady.

33-34 Men dance left hand across one quarter of the way round the set.

35-36 Men turn the lady they meet all the way round with the right hand. (First man turns second lady, second man turns third lady, third man turns fourth lady, fourth man turns first lady)

37-38 Men dance left hand across one quarter of the way round the set.

39-40 Men turn partner with the right hand and finish alongside them.

41-56 Second and fourth couples dance bars 17-32.

57-60 First and third couples set to partners and turn them three quarters of the way round with the right hand.

61-64 First and third couples dance half a reel of four, giving right shoulder to begin.

65-68 First and third couples turn partners three quarters of the way round with the left hand, and set to partner.

69-80 Second and fourth couples dance bars 57-68.

81-88 Four couples circle round and back.
