

The Moffat Jig
Jig 4x32

Written for the Moffat Scottish Country Dance Class

- 1-2 First man and third lady, second man and fourth lady, change places giving left hand.
- 3-6 The four ladies (at the top) and the four men (at the bottom) dance right hands across.
- 7-8 All dance two places round the set clockwise. (It may be necessary to pinch some time from the right hands across)
- 9-10 Third man (in first man's place) and first lady (in third lady's place), fourth man (in second man's place) and second lady (in fourth ladies place) change places giving left hand.
- 11-14 The four ladies (at the top) and the four men (at the bottom) dance right hands across.
- 15-16 A dance two places round the set clockwise. (It may be necessary to pinch some time from the right hands across). Finish 2,1,4,3.
- 17-24 Second and first couples, fourth and third couples dance rights and lefts. Omit polite turns at the end and face up and down on the sides. (facing the person you changed left hands with)
- 25-28 Dance half a reel of four on the sides passing right shoulder on the man's side and left shoulder on the ladies side to begin. Finish 3,4,1,2.
- 29-32 Second couple cast up to top place on their own sides, first, fourth and third couples step down on 31 and 32.

Repeat from new positions
